Client Permits may be required for work on site (Confined Space, Hot Work, etc.)		
Verify Public & Private Utilities on premises prior to any excavations!		
Barricades required for all excavations, overhead work areas, Controlled Access Zones		
Confirm placement of fuel or hazardous materials storage areas with TCES Superintendent		
PPE Requirements: Hard Hat, Eye protection, Hearing protection, Steel Toes, Gloves		
Fall Protection is required at 6' and in all MEWP including Scissor Lifts		
Clothing policy is long pants, High Visibility shirt, vest, coat (outerwear)		
Cell Phone use is allowed in work area for Business purposes only or in your vehicles		

Designated Break Area is your vehicle – remove all trash from jobsite

Only water is allowed on jobsite in your work areas

Eating/Drinking fluids other than water is allowed in your vehicle

Temporary Restrooms provided by TCES when applicable

Daily cleanup of your work area is required!

Failure to do so will result in back charges for TCES costs deducted from your subcontract

Report all injuries immediately to TCES Superintendent
